

## THE GUIDED TOUR OF THE OLD TOWN IN VALMIERA (on foot 1h)



We invite to get acquainted with the city of Valmiera accompanied by a guide, strolling through the Old Town's the most picturesque places and discovering the most interesting stories and legends of the city. On the route you will find out how through the centuries were mixed the destinies of Valmiera City and St. Simon's Church, where perhaps the ancient Beverina's Palace was located, where the only Gauja tram in the world stops, what stories can tell Valmiera's secular trees and many other interesting discoveries. **Duration:** 1 hour

**Length of the route:** ~ 2 km

**Starting point:** Valmiera St. Simon's Church at Bruninieku street 2

**The route includes:** the Valmiera St. Simon's Church, the Town Hall Square, the Valmiera Drama Theater, the Livonian Order Castle ruins, Valterkalnins, the Valmiera Museum buildings (Maršners House, the Old Pharmacy, the Valmiera Museum Exhibition Hall, the Herb Garden and the Pilskalns House), the River Gauja.

### The tour costs:

The tour of the Old Town <b>in Latvian</b> *	1 hour (60 minutes)	24,00 EUR
The tour of the Old Town <b>in foreign language</b> (English, Russian, German)*	1 hour (60 minutes)	36,00 EUR

\* Prices are for the size of the group up to 20 people. For the group over 20 people, extra charge per person **1.20 EUR (in Latvian), 1.80 EUR (in foreign language)**. Prices are listed for the guide service and they do not include extra costs for attending additional sightseeing objects.
